Degree Apprenticeships should offer students from low-income backgrounds an accessible, affordable, high-quality route onto the labour market. Yet Sutton Trust [research](#) shows that disadvantaged young people are consistently falling through the cracks:



of degree apprentices come from the least deprived areas



of degree apprentices are over the age of 30

Our work with state schools in deprived areas has identified three main barriers preventing disadvantaged students accessing Degree Apprenticeships:

1. An impenetrable application process

- ▶ Searching for vacancies is complex, requiring far more time than UG degrees.
- ▶ Applicants face a dizzying array of different application forms & timelines.

2. A lack of knowledge and confidence

- ▶ Applicants lack the professional vocabulary to make sense of job descriptions.
- ▶ Students unable to navigate language surrounding different market 'sectors.'

3. An absence of support

- ▶ Students need guidance on understanding, developing, and explaining soft skills.
- ▶ Overworked schools often lack the time and resources to put the scaffolding in place to support students through the long and complex application process.
