

2022-23 UCAS Timeline for Year 13s



- Complete final draft of personal statement (for applicants for 15th October deadline) see our editing tips here.
- Complete initial personal statement draft (for applicants for January deadline) see our 5 key tips here.
- 15th October 2022: UCAS deadline for applicants to Oxford, Cambridge and most medicine, veterinary and dentistry courses.
- Prepare for <u>interviews</u> if applicable.

November - December 2022

• Complete final draft of personal statement (for applications for January deadline) - see our editing tips here.

January – February 2023

- 25th January: UCAS deadline for the majority of undergraduate courses.
- Ensure you understand how to set your <u>firm and insurance</u> <u>choices</u>.
- 23th February: UCAS Extra opens. Ensure you know what it is and how to use it.



March – April 2023

- Research <u>UCAS Clearing and Adjustment</u>, making sure you understand why you might need it and how it works.
- Consider your possible results day outcomes and plan ahead for 'ideal', 'good' and 'below expectations' outcomes.

May - June 2023

- 18th May: the deadline by which universities normally respond to all applications.
- 30th June: Applications received after this time are entered into Clearing rather than sent onto universities directly.

July - August 2023

- 5th July: UCAS Clearing opens.
- TBC (usually mid-August): BTEC results announced.
- 17th August: <u>A-level results day</u>.
- TBC (usually mid-August): <u>UCAS Adjustment</u> opens.

September – October 2023

- TBC (usually start Sept): UCAS Adjustment closes.
- TBC (usually mid-Oct): last date for adding Clearing choices.
- TBC (usually mid-Oct): last date for universities to accept Clearing applicants.
